 - SCC should determine an annual project to carry out each year, with a 2nd project in mind should we go over our raised funds
 - We currently have an SCC revenue and expense account, as well as a hot lunch revenue and expense account. Michelle Cowan can print account summaries if we ask. SCC to start monthly reports for each meeting starting in October
